Line

A mark archers must stand behind.

Range

The area where archery is practiced.

Release

To let go of the arrow to shoot it.

Score

The number of points an archer gets.

"Her score was the highest in the group."

Sight

A small tool on the bow to help aim.

"He adjusted the sight for better accuracy."

Target

The object that archers aim at.

"She hit the center of the target."
