Apex

The middle of a turn.

"The rider aimed for the apex of the corner, using precise steering and throttle control to maintain speed and minimize the distance traveled, ensuring optimal performance."

Brakes

Stops the bike.

Crash

An accident.

Engine

Leathers

Overtake

Paddock

Area for teams and bikes.

Pit Stop

Changing tires or refuel

"The rider came in for a quick pit stop to change tires, a strategic move that could improve performance but also cost valuable time in the race so it must be fast."

Podium

The winner's stage.

Qualifying

Session to set race order.

"The rider pushed hard in qualifying to secure a good starting position on the grid, recognizing the importance of being near the front for the race start."

Suspension

System that absorbs bumps.

"The mechanic adjusted the suspension to improve the bike's handling on the bumpy track, aiming to provide the rider with more comfort and control."

Throttle

Controls the speed.

"The rider twisted the throttle to increase speed on the straightaway, precisely managing the power output to gain an advantage over competitors."

Tires

Rubber wheels.

"The team changed the tires to ensure maximum grip on the track, allowing the racer to take corners quickly and safely in varying conditions."

Track

The racing road.

Warm Up

Practice before the race.
